

Description of the institutional grading system

Academic year 2023-2024

The grade scale goes from 0 to 20/20. The pass grade to get the credits of a teaching unit is 10/20. At the end of the academic year the jury gives the credits for all the courses with a grade of at least 10/20. It can also give credits for a small failure if the average result is good.

Exams are organised at the end of the semester (in January or in June). If the student fails at one or more exams, he/she can resit these exams in August/September.

ABS = absent (the student didn't take the exam)

EXC = excused (the student couldn't take the exam because of illness or other serious reason)

FRDE = fraud (the student committed fraud or plagiarism during an assessment)

PRS = attendance note (the student came to the exam but didn't answer any questions)
